- Has two Ohio Lottery MP vending machines, and one instant/online vending machine.


#### Rick's thoughts on games and operations

- On Perfect Game 300: "People are all over it here."
- On equipment: "The terminal behind the bar is easy to operate and the vending machines are easy to use."
- On the importance of selling Lottery: "If you're on the fence, you're crazy not to bring on *Keno*. Everyone benefits," he says. He earned approximately \$64,000 in commissions last year.
- On promotions: A free ticket promotion with a Keno purchase (like the Keno/March Mania basketball promotion) provide the best results for his business.
