We also remind you that the Lottery is only a game and should be played for fun and entertainment. Some people, however, end up spending more than they plan or budget.

A few tips on playing the Lottery responsibly:

- NEVER gamble with borrowed money.
- Bet only what you can afford to lose.
- Know your odds.
- Set a limit, and stick to it.
- Bet with your head, not above it.

How can you tell if someone has a gambling problem?

Ask these questions:

1. Have you ever felt the need to bet more and more money?
2. Have you ever had to lie to people important to you about how much you gamble?

If you've answered "yes" to **one or both** of these questions, it may indicate a gambling problem.
