Patsy's Bar & Grille, Campbell

Alex Palombo Jr. knows how to sell. After selling cars for 32 years, he changed careers and purchased Patsy's Bar & Grille in 2006. The bar had a 60-year track record, and as a patron under its former owner, Alex saw the business as a good investment.

Business stats

- Alex has eight part-time employees, including a daughter and grandson.
- His business is cozy, with 14 barstools and five tables serving patrons. It's almost always busy.

Lottery/Keno focus

Provides personal attention. While the business has MP vending, the staff handles the majority of his patrons' *Keno* wager requests.

"We wait on our people. We wait on all our *Keno* customers. That's what they like," Alex says. "They stay here. You keep them here and they play while they're eating and drinking."

His Keno clientele

Knows his customers, their habits. Patsy's Bar & Grille does the majority of its *Keno* business between 11 a.m. and 7 p.m., with retirees and shift workers among his regulars.

While *Keno* is the largest draw, he sells all games including about six instants. While many patrons play these other games, he says that they tend to do so at other retailers where they've also developed an allegiance.

Future goals

Maximize the use of space. He's working on a remodeling project that would allow him to accommodate five to six more patrons at the bar. He hopes to have the remodel completed in 2014.

The power of pool play

"I started a list. I had everyone pay up first. It took me 24 hours," she says.

Angie got 16 patrons to pool their money for a big *Keno* ticket purchase. Each paid \$50 for a total of 20 drawings, and got 80 free 4-spot tickets.
