The Ohio Lottery Commission is issuing this bulletin to licensed technology providers to provide a status on the program and procedures.

Shipment procedures have not been updated; however the OLC would like to draw your attention to the requirement for submitting a sample manifest and description of packaging security. If you have not done so, please provide that information as described in the procedure. The OLC will acknowledge receipt and approve submissions.

The VLT terminal standards will be updated to include additional standards. The updated version will be posted on Monday, April 16. Please revisit the document and direct any question to Michael.Petro@olc.state.oh.us.

Each game theme must be submitted for approval by the Lottery Commission. The theme must be presented using game slicks or similar form which identifies denomination, play style, and prize payouts. The OLC has a minimum payout of 85 percent therefore the game must be configurable above that level. To provide adequate time for review and for presentation to the Commissioners, the OLC requests that themes be submitted at least 60 days before proposed installation at a facility.

Finally, the OLC has issued a conditional license to Scioto Downs. Shipments are authorized to the facility and to an alternate location at: Commercial Works, 1299 Boltonfield Street, Columbus, Ohio. Shipping Manifests should be submitted in advance as described in the Operating Procedures.
