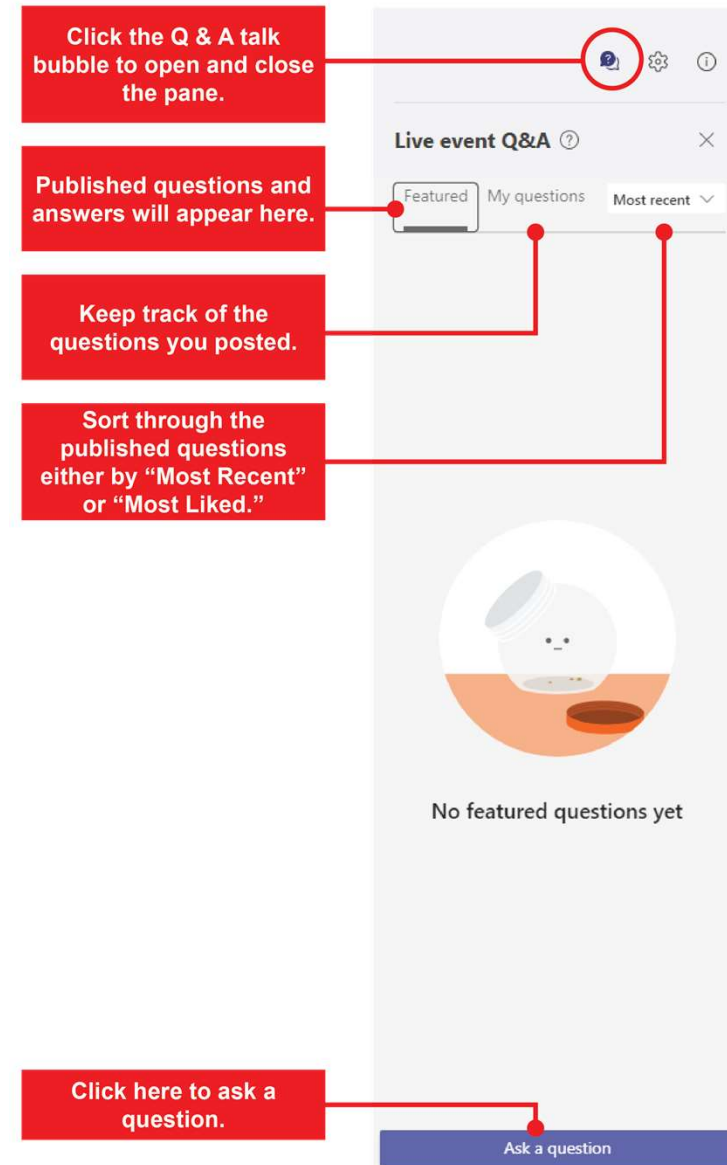

Type C Host Update

Lottery Host rules, operating procedures, and updated VEP rules were posted to the Lottery Sports Gaming webpage under the Announcements tab. The rules are moving forward in the CSI process.

The Ohio Lottery Commission has prepared the following documents for public comment:

Lottery Type C Host Pre-Qualification

On May 4th over 2,000 potentially eligible Lottery Retailers received an email notification to pre-qualify for a Host license.

As of today, over 500 retailers have completed the interest form for Lottery approval.

Host Pre-Qualification Recap

Are you interested in Lottery Sports gaming?

Dear Ohio Lottery Retailers,

On 12/08/2021 HB 29 was passed to allow licensed lottery sales agents who also hold a valid D1, D2, or D5 liquor permit to apply for a Type C Sports Gaming Host license through the Ohio Casino Control Commission (OCCC).

To be eligible to apply for a sports gaming license, a retailer must:

1. Have a valid Ohio Lottery sales agent license
2. Be in good standing with the Lottery's rules and regulations.
3. Have a written recommendation from the Ohio Lottery to be issued a Type-C Gaming License.
4. Not be a not-for-profit corporation or associate.
5. Have a valid D1, D2, or D5 liquor permit.

If you meet these criteria and are interested in becoming licensed by OCCC, please click the link below and fill out the information to start the pre-qualification process with the Ohio Lottery.

During the month of May, Lottery staff will be processing the interest forms to verify eligibility requirements.

Beginning in June, the Lottery will start posting pre-qualified hosts on the OLC website for Proprietors to access.

The OCCC e-licensing portal for Hosts is expected to be available for formal applications starting on July 15th.

Proprietor License Requirements

Proprietor License Requirements:

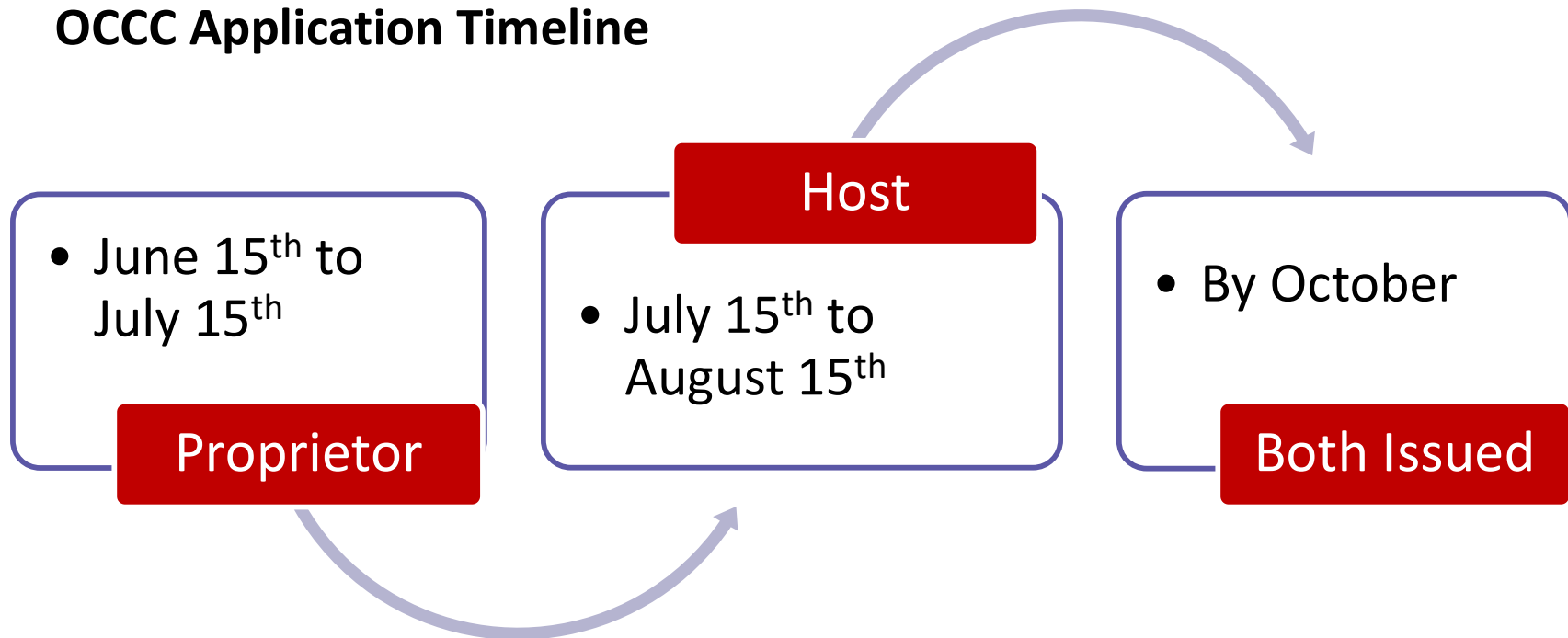
Per House Bill 29, the OCCC shall license at least two, and not more than twenty, type C sports gaming proprietors at any one time.*

The proprietor license is valid for five years.

The OCCC license application for Proprietors available starting on June 15th.

**If only one eligible type C sports gaming proprietor applies, the commission shall issue the license.*

*Any applications received beyond the outlined dates will not be guaranteed licensure prior to the universal start date

Batch 1 – Duties & Operating Standards

Posted April 29th

Comments closed May 11th

Effective in October

Batch 2 – Financial Processing Expectations

Posted May 10th

Comments close May 20th

Effective in October

- **3-5-01: Proprietor Duties**
 - Notify Lottery on changes, two terminal limit, VEP proposal, additional ORC sections
- **3-5-02: Required Procedures**
 - Establish and maintain required procedures
- **3-5-03: House Rules**
 - Readily available, details on wagers, bet types, ticket policies, changes expected

- **3-6-01: Sports Gaming Systems**
 - Detect unauthorized use, technical specifications, disaster recovery procedures
- **3-6-02: Information Technology**
 - Basic proprietor IT system requirements
- **3-6-03: Equipment Approval and Testing**
 - Certified independent testing, comply with GLI standards
- **3-6-04: Equipment for Hosts**
 - Proprietor cover cost of consumables, equipment maintenance/service/acquisition
- **3-6-05: Incident Reporting**
 - Types of incidents, prevention procedures

- **3-7-01: Wager Rules**
 - Bet types, \$700 velocity control, cancelling wagers
- **3-7-02: Tickets**
 - Ticket display, expiration timeline, back of ticket messaging
- **3-7-03: Advertising**
 - Program approval procedures, cost, restrictions
- **3-7-04: Promotions and Bonuses**
 - Requirements, Restrictions, procedures

- **3-8-01: Revenue and Compensation**
 - Weekly revenue collection
 - A proprietor who operates a system independent of the current lottery system shall remit 10% of gross sports gaming revenue
 - A proprietor who is approved to utilize existing lottery systems shall remit 60% of gross sports gaming revenue
 - Host compensation

- **3-8-02: Prize Payments**
 - Payment types
 - Allow for Host cashing \$600 or less
 - Multiple options for cashing over \$600
 - Lottery processing option
 - Intercept and Withholding for prizes \$600 and above

- **3-8-03: Accounting and Revenue Audit**
 - Documented procedures
 - Lottery access

- Technical reviews & implementation timelines

Host Partnerships

- Start facilitating agreements for full-service Host solutions

Conditional Contracts

- OLC & Proprietor terms pending formal licensure
