# Mansfield Eagles, Mansfield

You can find the Mansfield Eagles hopping throughout the day – especially mid-afternoon and evenings. The chapter, which opened more than 70 years ago, has about 700 members, who enjoy the fun, friendly atmosphere and good causes supported by the Fraternal Order of Eagles.

**Steve Schroeder**, the chapter secretary, has been a member for more than 20 years and serves as a trustee. He's been chapter secretary since 2021.

"I talk up the Lottery wherever I go," says Steve, who regularly speaks to other fraternal organizations around the state. He encouraged the chapter to bring in lottery games in 2014.

Like many bar-tavern style retailers, *Keno* is a big draw. However, the most popular games by far are touchscreen TAP games. The fraternal has set aside an area for gaming, where Lottery vending machines offer traditional, Touch & Win and Tap games for members.

"The whole place plays Lottery," says sales representative **Jimmie Parsons**.

One of Steve's goals as chapter secretary is to provide his members with a wide variety of entertainment options. He's a Lottery player himself and has some special numbers he enjoys playing occasionally too. Funds raised through all these efforts support special charities and good causes adopted by the Mansfield Eagles.

"We're one big family," says Steve, "and we take care of each other."

- The Fraternal Order of Eagles was founded in 1898 by a group of theater owners. Today, the organization has more than 150,000 members in the U.S. and Canada. Entertainer Bob Hope and musician Billy Ray Cyrus are among the fraternal's members.

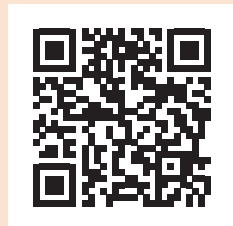

# Taking Care of Business: TLC for MP and Touch & Win vending

Ticket dust and other grime can affect the operation of your vending machine. Periodically, a couple minutes of light cleaning will help keep vending in good working order.

Sales representatives suggest you take special note of the area around your bill collector. An occasional wipe down keeps the mechanism in good working order. A soft cloth or alcohol swab works best.

After removing the cash box, pull the frame out a few inches to expose the rollers for the bill reader (illuminated in red light). Give the rollers a good wipe.

Wipe down the front of the bill acceptor too.
